- To confirm if you are claiming a discount as a member of the D&S Condors. To be eligible you must ensure that no discounts are accepted from another club of which you are a member.

£35.00 for non-club coaches

£25.00 for existing club coaches attending as a refresher*

D&S Condors members:-

£17.50 for non-club coaches

Free for existing club coaches attending as a refresher*

**The BHPA recommends that club coaches re-attend a course at least every 5 years.*

To be eligible to claim a discount as a Condors member you must verify that you are not receiving a discount as a member of another club.

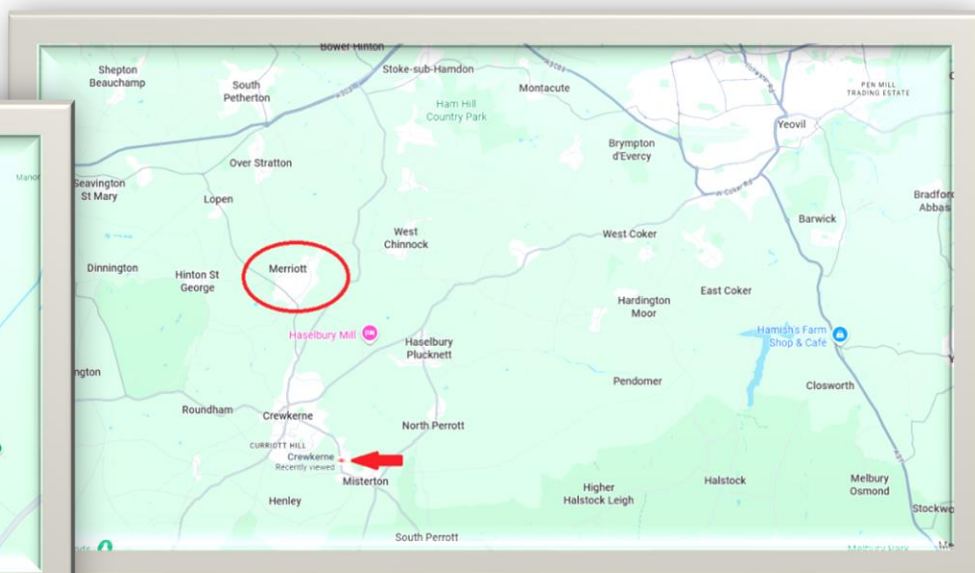
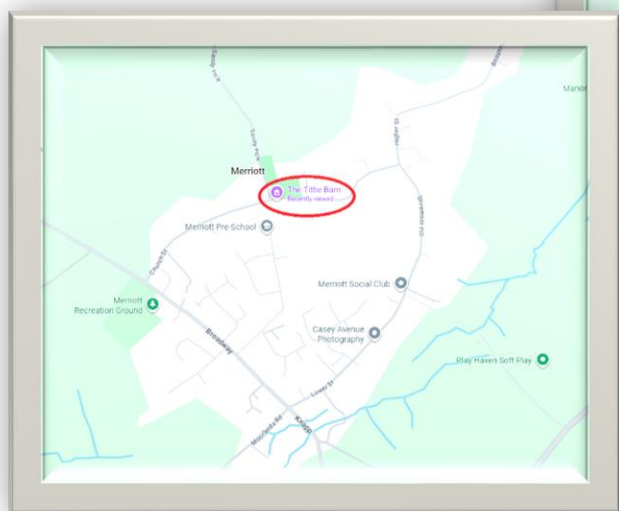
Getting There

Merriott is a village located approximately 2 miles North of Crewkerne and 7 miles West of Yeovil.

There is car parking available on site with the option to overflow onto adjacent roads if necessary.

Food & Refreshments

Tea and coffee will be provided at the start of each day and at the mid-morning and mid-afternoon breaks.

Lunchtimes are short and you may wish to bring a packed lunch or food that can be prepared at the venue. The barn has a fully provisioned kitchen with oven, microwave, crockery etc.

There is a café across the road and various other food outlets in the village.

What to Bring

The BHPA will provide a folder containing copies of the slides used in the various presentations. All you need to bring is a pen and paper for any additional notes you may need to make.

Notes on the Course and becoming a Club Coach

This is an “attendance only” course. There are no tests or exams and, providing you fully attend both days, you will be deemed to have successfully completed the course.

Attending the course does not obligate you to become a club coach. Many people attend the course to gain an insight into the coaching environment without ever wishing to take the next step into coaching other pilots.

Likewise, completing the course, does not guarantee that you will be accepted as a club coach.



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You will be provided with a form at the end of the final day to confirm you have successfully completed the course and, to become a Club Coach, this form will need to be countersigned by your club's Chief Coach. The Chief Coach has the responsibility to ensure that they consider you suitable for the position and that you meet the BHPA requirements detailed in the Technical Manual. A Club Coach position only remains valid if your club's Chief Coach validates its renewal each year.
